CONTAINERS, DISHES AND PLATES have been left in the kitchen. Look in the boxes under the counter just inside the kitchen door. One may be yours!

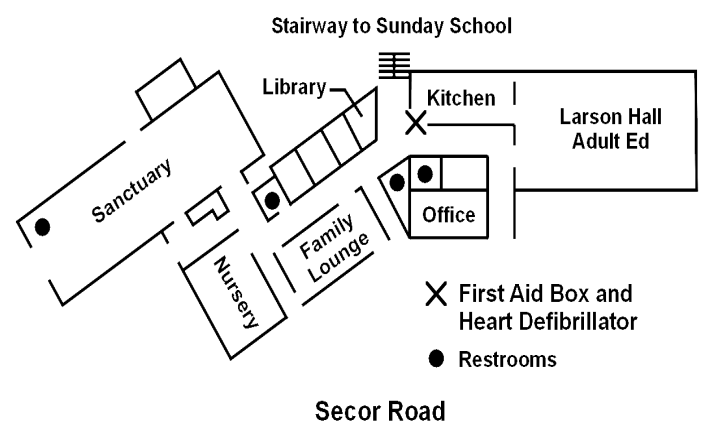
