**BLOOD PRESSURE SCREENINGS** will be done on Sunday, June 14, in Larson Hall between the services.

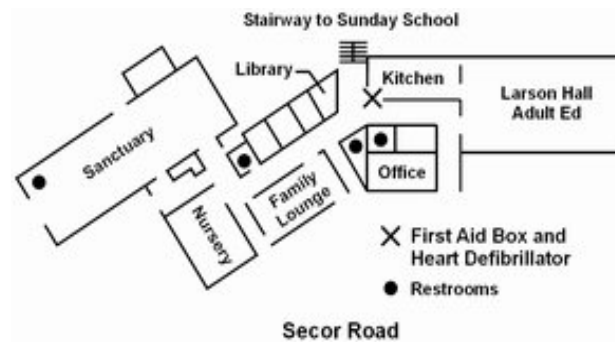
