of the Holy Spirit.



Reader: ²⁹Indeed, all who sleep in the earth shall bow down in worship; all who go down to the dust, though they be dead, shall kneel before the LORD.



THE GOSPEL JOHN 15:1-8



Just as the branch cannot bear fruit by itself unless it abides in the vine, neither can you unless you abide in me. ⁵I am the vine, you are the branches. 



THE LORD'S PRAYER


