**OLD TESTAMENT READING**

**ECCLESIASTES 5:10-20**

<sup>10</sup>The lover of money will not be satisfied with money; nor the lover of wealth, with gain. This also is vanity. <sup>11</sup>When goods increase, those who eat them increase; and what gain has their owner but to see them with his eyes? <sup>12</sup>Sweet is the sleep of laborers, whether they eat little or much; but the surfeit of the rich will not let them sleep. <sup>13</sup>There is a grievous ill that I have seen under the sun: riches were kept by their owners to their hurt, <sup>14</sup>and those riches were lost in a bad venture; though they are parents of children, they have nothing in their hands. <sup>15</sup>As they came from their mother's womb, so they shall go again, naked as they came; they shall take nothing for their toil, which they may carry away with their hands. <sup>16</sup>This also is a grievous ill: just as they came, so shall they go; and what gain do they have from toiling for the wind? <sup>17</sup>Besides, all their days they eat in darkness, in much vexation and sickness and resentment. <sup>18</sup>This is what I have seen to be good: it is fitting to eat and drink and find enjoyment in all the toil with which one toils under the sun the few days of the life God gives us; for this is our lot. <sup>19</sup>Likewise all to whom God gives wealth and possessions and whom he enables to enjoy them, and to accept their lot and find enjoyment in their toil — this is the gift of God. <sup>20</sup>For they will scarcely brood over the days of their lives, because God keeps them occupied with the joy of their hearts.
