The offering will be collected in baskets at the door and communion will be distributed as people leave. We will not be passing the peace.

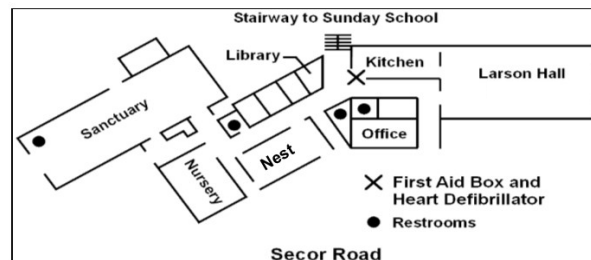
The nursery will not be available and we will not be serving coffee and cookies.

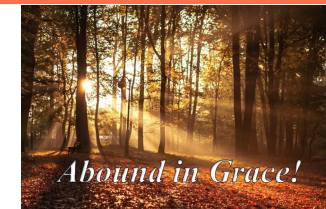
If you are a guest this morning, please notice the staff and lay leaders wearing identification badges. They will be able to assist you.
