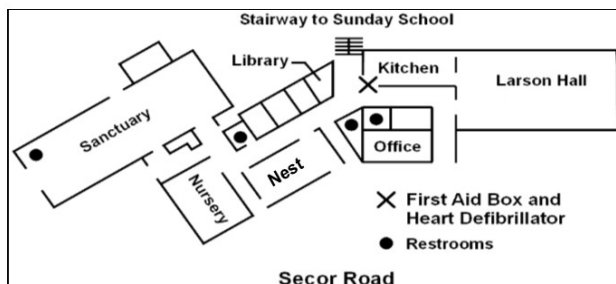
"I tell you the truth, whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers of mine, you did to me" (Matthew 25:40).

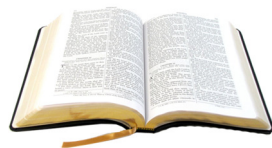
